

Policies and Procedures

Toc H Australia is committed to undertaking all its activities in a safe and caring manner, in compliance with all relevant Australian State and Commonwealth legislation, and reflecting our Vision Statement, Mission, and the Four Points of the Compass.

Most Toc H activities and projects are conducted by members of Branches in either the Northern Region (Qld, NSW, ACT and NT) and Southern Region (SA, Vic, Tas and WA). Both Regions have policies and procedures which can be accessed by contacting them through their respective web sites. These policies and procedures are reviewed and, if necessary, updated at least every three years.

All members of the governing bodies of Northern and Southern Region, all Branch officials, and any member or members responsible for managing any Toc H Project, are required to be familiar with all Toc H policies and procedures that apply in their respective regions.

Toc H members responsible for conducting any work in relation to Toc H, and managing any Toc H project, including projects conducted in partnership with other organisations, are required to ensure that all project participants are aware of all relevant Toc H policy and procedural obligations pertaining to the activities they are undertaking.

All members of Toc H and volunteers are required to comply with all relevant policies and procedures in their respective region, in relation to the work or activity they are undertaking.
